

NovaJet Print Driver

1. Download the driver from A&E's website to your desktop.
2. Go to **Start – Settings – Printers** and then click **Add Printer**
3. Select **Local Printer** (uncheck the automatically detect box) then click **Next**
4. Use the following port - choose **File** – then click **Next**
5. Click the **Have Disk Button**
6. Browse to where the driver is (desktop)
7. Highlight the **wasatch.inf** file then **Next**
8. Choose the **NovaJet Pro 60e** printer and click **Next**
9. Leave printer name as is and click **Next**
10. Do not make this your default printer then click **Next**
11. Do not share this printer and do not print a test page
12. Click **Next** and then **Finish**
13. Now go to **Start – Settings – Printers**
14. You will see the printer you just installed (NovaJet Pro 60e)
15. Look closely and you will see that the printer has a little disk on it. This indicates that the printer will only print to file (not paper).
16. You can now select this printer to make **PostScript** files to send to A&E

Xerox 6060 Print Driver

1. Download the driver from A&E's website to your desktop.
2. Go to **Start – Settings – Printers** and then click **Add Printer**
3. Select **Local Printer** (uncheck the automatically detect box) then click **Next**
4. Use the following port - choose **File** – then click **Next**
5. Click the **Have Disk Button**
6. Browse to where the driver is (desktop)
7. Highlight the **oemsetup.inf** file then **Next**
8. Choose the **DocuColor 2000 v1.2** printer and click **Next**
9. Leave printer name as is and click **Next**
10. Do not make this your default printer then click **Next**
11. Do not share this printer and do not print a test page
12. Click **Next** and then **Finish**
13. Now go to **Start – Settings – Printers**
14. You will see the printer you just installed (DocuColor 2000 v1.2)
15. Look closely and you will see that the printer has a little disk on it. This indicates that the printer will only print to file (not paper).
16. You can now select this printer to make **PostScript** files to send to A&E

Xerox 6155 B&W Print Driver
